

TOMISLAV NEDIĆ - CV

Tomislav Nedić was born on December 20, 1991 in Zagreb. After completing the Jesuit classical high school with public law in Osijek in 2010, he entered the Faculty of Law of the University of J.J. Strossmayer in Osijek, where he graduated in 2015. A year later, he completed the Professional Development Program for Lawyers-Linguists at the same faculty. During his studies, he improved and participated in a large number of legal conferences, seminars, law schools and competitions in Italy (Altiero Spinelli Institute, Ventotene, 2012), the Netherlands (ICTY, The Hague, 2012), Germany (Bundestag, Reichstag, Berlin, 2013), Hungary (University of Pecs, Pecs, 2013), and Serbia (Faculty of Political Sciences, Belgrade, 2013). While still a student, he published his first scientific papers independently and in co-authorship. As a student, he was a member of the Faculty and University sports team in tennis. After completing his studies, he holds the position of Secretary General of the Center for Integrative Bioethics of J.J. Strossmayer University of Osijek as a scientific unit of the Scientific Center of Excellence for Integrative Bioethics, which, by definition, brings together the most internationally successful Croatian scientists in the field of bioethics. At the end of 2019, he was employed as an assistant at the Academy of Arts and Culture of the University of J.J. Strossmayer in Osijek (Department of Culture, Media and Management), where he participates in teaching courses in intellectual property and scientific methodology (with an emphasis on artists' copyrights, with Associate Professor Dubravka Klasiček, Ph.D.). In December 2021, he was employed as an assistant at the Faculty of Law in Osijek at the Department of Civil and Civil Procedure Law. He received his Ph.D. in law at the Faculty of Law in Osijek (average 5.0) on July 6, 2022. In addition to successfully passing the distinction exam, as a scholarship holder of the Osijek-Baranja County, he is also a student of the postgraduate doctoral study in Philosophy at the Faculty of Philosophy of the University of Zagreb. He was a visiting researcher at King's College London, The Dickson Poon School of Law (The Centre for Technology, Ethics, Law and Society; 2023). He is the author of one book and thirty papers (scientific papers, book chapters, conference proceedings) in the fields of private and civil law, bioethics, animal ethics, and legal and moral philosophy. His scientific interests include the areas of civil law (private law theory and general part of civil law), property law, philosophical-ethical foundations of private law, legal thinghood and personhood, bioethics, and animal ethics. He also published his papers in philosophical, bioethical, political, economic, medical, anthropological/ethnological and sociological journals and books. Reviewer for several social and humanistic journals. He speaks English (actively) and German (passively) and uses Latin (taken instead of English as the 1st foreign language of the State Matura, A level) and ancient Greek in his scientific work. Winner of several awards and scholarships: Osijek-Baranja County scholarship holder for postgraduate doctoral studies (2022/2023), Award for excellence in scientific and research work of the Academy of Arts and Culture of the University of J.J. Strossmayer in Osijek (2021), Rector's Award for excellence and seminar work in the field of European public law (2013), Dean's Award for Excellence (2011 and 2012), University scholarship for the most successful students of the University of J.J. Strossmayer in Osijek (2011 and 2012). Tomislav is a member of the Governing Board of the Croatian Philosophical Society, a head of the Philosophy of Law Section of the Croatian Philosophical Society, a member of the Governing Board of the

Croatian Bioethical Society, a member of the Presidency of Matrix Croatica, a scientific associate of the Scientific Centre of Excellence for Integrative Bioethics, associate of the Croatian Medical Chamber and associate of the Croatian Medical Association.
